Theme: "The Sounds of Christmas"

Bring entries to the Parkside on Sunday, Nov 29, between 10:00 and 11:30 am.

SECTION A - Floral Design

CLASS:

1. **"Oh Tannenbaum"** – a wreath using fresh plant material...may use up to 20% dried material
2. **"Memories"** - a wreath using any dried plant material
3. **"Deck the Halls"** - wall or door décor, not a wreath, using fresh and/or dried plant material
4. **"With Candles all Aglow"** – a line design using candle(s)
5. **"Sounds of the Season"** – a design on a musical theme, incorporating any real or ornamental musical instrument
6. **"Walking in a Winter Wonderland"** – a design in mostly white using fresh and/or dried plant material (may be silver, grey, or cream hues)
7. **"Bright Copper Kettles, & Warm Woolen Mittens"** – a centrepiece in a copper container
8. **"Hark the Herald Angels Sing"** – a design incorporating an angel
9. **"Baby, it's Cold Outside"** – a pave design
10. **"Bells on Bobtail Ring"** – a design using any type of sleigh
11. **Beginners Class:**
"We Want Some Figgy Pudding" – a seasonal table centrepiece (pudding not required :-)

Creative Design

12. **"Oh Holy Night"** – your interpretation of the Nativity...remember to include a floral design.

NOTE: - Unless otherwise stated, all materials used in design must be fresh...never plastic or silk.
- All entries must consist of at least 75% natural material (need not be homegrown) ...**except for # 3, which may incorporate a container/structure that may be up to 50% of the design.**
- Suitable accessories (bows, bells, figurines, etc.) are allowed, up to 25% of total design content.
- Sprayed cones/branches **are allowed** in floral designs (paint, snow, glitter, etc.) **but not plastic.**
- Wreaths may be oval, square, etc...not necessarily round...and ready to hang!
- **Beginners' class is for those members who have never yet entered a design.**

SECTION B - Festive Features

13. Gingerbread House/Cottage
14. Cranberry Sauce (cooked)
15. Jam or Jelly (any fruit - specify on label)
16. Arts & Crafts (stitching, quilting, painting...show us your talent!)
17. Hand-made Greeting Card

NOTE: Entries 14 and 15 will be tasted. Entries in class 15 must 'pop' when opened.
